

I Wish Her Well is an intricate performance, combining storytelling, high tempo energy and an evocative sound score by British composer Nathaniel Reed that infuses the performance with melody and atmosphere. It is a captivating production that seeks to move and engage. Act one is based on the stories of four women who are closely related to the dancers, whilst act two is based on the diaries of a 16 year-old girl. She is now an 85 year-old woman who generously shared her thoughts and experiences with the choreographers and dancers. The production period took place in Norway, Sweden and Tanzania, culminating in a premiere performance for CODA Oslo International Dance Festival's 10th anniversary at the Dance House, Oslo, in 2012. The performance has continued on tour in Norway, Sweden, Denmark, England, Zimbabwe

and Tanzania. Four women, a collection of stories, a handful of hourglasses and a huge mirror. I Wish Her Well tells simple stories of everyday events that are universally meaningful, but nonetheless remain invisible when official history is written.

Oliver meddles with forces we barely understand, in a comedy magic show for the QI generation. His magic combines with other interesting things to create work that is "fascinating and different to other magicians".

His one-man magic shows have sold out month-long runs at the Edinburgh Fringe in both 2013 and 2014, as well as sell-out performances in London, Brighton Fringe, Buxton Fringe, Green Man Festival and Manchester Comedy Festival.

Oliver's shows have toured across England and Wales, to both rural venues and urban theatres. He has performed at The Barbican, London 2012 Olympics, and Wales Millennium Centre. He has also filmed with the team behind E4's Troy.

Red Moon Road, the Winnipeg folk trio is known for surviving adversity, spinning stories into songs and, stunning musicianship. They formed in 2012 by Daniel Jordan, Sheena Rattai and Daniel Peloguin-Hopfner. They have toured extensively, to 7 countries in Europe and North America with 'Sorrows and Glories' (their third album, released in Autumn 2015). It has already spent three weeks at number one on the Earshot! National Folk/Roots/Blues Charts and has delighted listeners world wide. Live, Red Moon Road makes a much bigger sound than one would expect from a trio. In an impressive well-choreographed show, bordering on spectacle, the trio incorporates impeccable threepart harmonies, a roots drum kit split entertainingly but pragmatically between two band members and an acoustic guitar rigged to also be a bass.

A moustached man plays mandolin, lap steel, banjo and organ, and subtle technological wizardry whirls as the

unmistakable soulful voice of one of Canada's premiere songstresses floats above it all. Honed in house concerts and main stage festival appearances alike, Red Moon Road is a tapestry of song, masterful storytelling and spontaneous repartee woven seamlessly into something truly exceptional. Spanning a wide range of genres, from a Beatlesesque pop song, to full-on spiritual and jazz and innovative instrumental work. With tastes of Albertan country, Parisian aires, banjo driven anthems and the tradition folk storytelling in a Canadiana style, the music carries the stories as compellingly as the lyrics.

DARE DEVIL RIDES TO JARAMA: A NEW PLAY BY NEIL GORE

Barton-on-Humber

Commissioned by the International Brigades Memorial Trust, the play's tour will coincide with the 80th anniversaries of the creation of the International Brigades in October 1936 and the Battle of Jarama in 1937.

The drama centres on the contrasting lives of International Brigaders Clem Beckett and Christopher Caudwell. Beckett, a Lancashire blacksmith and famous star of the speedway track, and Caudwell, a renowned writer, poet and philosopher, were killed together at Jarama in February 1937, having become friends as members of the British Battalion's machine-gun company.



The play sheds light on the political and social world of the 1930s and commemorate and celebrate the contribution and sacrifice of the volunteers. Dare Devil Rides To Jarama captures the raw passions and emotions produced by the

Spanish Civil War – idealism to despair, hope to anger, determination to fear – through powerful storytelling, stirring song and poetry, and compelling movement and dance.
